


Very easy to register to accurately check the number of CPC you have in hand towards your next 35 hours, if you are not happy doing this yourself then speak with someone in the office and they'll do it for you. Once registered you'll receive a letter, sent to the address on your licence, with a code on it and you'll need to log back into the system within 21 days of receiving this, again if you are not happy doing this take your letter into a Backline Office and they'll do it for you.

So how?



4. Fill in with your **“Driving licence number”** and **“Postcode”** – needs to be the postcode on your licence.

5. When you click on **“Register”** it'll say one of three things
  - a. You'll receive your pass code within 3 working days.
  - b. You have already registered – try some memorable passwords if that does not work select the following.

- c. If it is saying you are not on the system the likelihood is you have none registered against you name as at least one CPC needs registering.

The letter you receive will have a unique password on it, once logged in with this password it'll ask you to change to a memorable password.
